
DID YOU KNOW?

YOU CAN ASK THE JUDGE TO ORDER ANY OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

✔ **Respondent can attend a 26-Week Certified Batterers Intervention Program.**

This is a special counseling program designed to hold batterers accountable for their actions, and teaches the tools of nonviolent, respectful behavior that you deserve.

✔ **Respondent to keep a certain distance away from you.**

This includes not calling, contacting, driving by, or contacting you through other people.

✔ **Respondent to exchange your child-in-common through a neutral third party.**

You do not need to be alone with the Respondent when you exchange the children for visits.

✔ **Respondent to pay child support.**

The Respondent will still be financially responsible, even if they are not living at home.

✔ **Respondent to participate in a mental health and/or substance abuse evaluation.**

If an evaluation suggests treatment is needed, the treatment can be ordered as well.
